



WHAT IS EVENTING?

Eventing is an Olympic equestrian sport consisting of three phases, historically held over three days - the triathlon of equestrian sport! The rider must ride the same horse for all phases, a true test of rideability, courage, and carefulness. A format change in the early 2000s made the event shorter, now commonly held on one day and referred to as a "horse trial" at the lower levels. The terms eventing and horse trials are used interchangeably.

The three phases of an Event or Horse Trial are:

DRESSAGE
CROSS COUNTRY
SHOW JUMPING

FUNDRAISING PRIORITIES

1. SUPPORTING NB CROSS COUNTRY Facilities for all levels

HTNB competitions range from fun practice competitions, to national and internationally sanctioned events. There is something for everyone, as a volunteer, spectator, or competitor.

Jump and course maintenance requires considerable time and money. Our fundraising efforts support local eventing facilities with the goal of preparing riders of all levels to enjoy and advance in the sport. This includes maintenance of existing courses, such as mowing, painting and jump repairs as well as building new jumps to expand the current courses - adding opportunities for our riders.

2. HTNB INTERNATIONAL RIDER FUND

In the sport of Eventing in Canada, riders have historically faced limited opportunities to experience international competition, with only one Federation Equestre International (FEI) event hosted at Bromont,Quebec. New Brunswick riders have faced long distance travel and expenses to qualify and compete at an International level. However, in 2018 Foshay International hosted its successful inaugural event in Jemseg, NB. A homegrown opportunity to compete at FEI is an exciting addition to our community and to our rider's wishlists. These riders may go on to represent Team Canada someday!
